The Individual Health Record

Supporting safer, better care when your GP surgery is closed at evenings and weekends

Your Individual Health Record shares parts of your GP medical record with people who are caring for you if you are unwell out of hours, or in an emergency.

It gives doctors and health professionals valuable information to help them make the best decisions about your care.

Your Individual Health Record can only be seen by health professionals at local emergency and out of hours services that serve your GP practice. They must ask you if you agree before they look at your information.
